About this demo site

This demo site is a working model of a CommuniShare application for a fictional community, the "CommuniShare County Community College" (CCCC). This "community" is composed of students, faculty, staff, alumni and local area residents. The demo has actual "canned" entries posted in it by a number of "canned" members of the community.

You'll be able to log in as one of these "canned" members, or create a new member identity. In either case, you can search for or browse the entries posted by others, add (and modify or delete) your own entries, view member profiles, read the FAQ's and so on. (What you won't be able to do is send emails to other "canned" members, since they don't really exist.) However, since this is not an actual community, the index will be periodically reset, and all "new" (that is, other than "canned") members and entries will be
